

33 Charles Street is a completely restored four-story, beautifully proportioned home in prime West Village. Because of its position on Charles, the sunlight is extraordinary through its French windows and doors. This townhouse features six wood-burning fireplaces, central air throughout, new kitchen and baths, and a deep, beautifully planted garden.

Basement Level – Clean, dry storage, laundry with two washers and two dryers, and sidewalk access.

Garden Floor – Family room with working fireplace, 15' x 22' country kitchen with brick floor and French doors to an impeccably maintained garden with Dogwood, Japanese Maple and Crabapple trees.

Parlour Floor – Beautifully restored original detail in the living room and library, each with a wood-burning fireplace. There are original narrow oak-strip floors, French windows front and French doors rear unto Juliet balconies, and surround sound throughout.

Third Floor – South Master Bedroom with French windows and wood-burning fireplace, two huge walk-in closets, one of which could be a sitting room or nursery, and new oversized bathroom with two sinks, soaking tub and separate stall shower.

Fourth Floor – Truly unique top floor. Two bedrooms, open study, hangout room with three skylights and roof access; new bathroom.
